appointed for the purpose of distributing the Real
Estate of Wm. D. Stone late of said County
deceased, in the hands of Robert A. Stone
Administrator, report: that we did on Mon-
day the 15th of Nov. just last passed, enter upon
the discharge of said duty, after first having
given the legal notice to the parties, at interest, and
having taken the Oath prescribed by Law, and hav-
ing employed J. F. Adams Surveyor to assist us
the Admr Robt. A. Stone, placed in our hands a
plat representing (15-21) fifteen hundred and twenty
one acres, and this was ⁽¹⁾ seven heirs, or distrib-
utors. We directed the Surveyor to divide and lay
off said land into seven equal shares or divisions
which we did divide into seven shares of 217 acres
each. we then proceeded to value each and separate
ly as follows--

We then proceeded to distribute the Lots
among the Distributors in the following man-
ner--viz. The lots were numbered and written
on pieces of paper of the same size with
the same dimensions -- each, and of view of
the same size and placed in a hat and
said hat covered with a handkerchief, then
names of the Distributors were written on pieces
of paper of the same size, folded in like

manner and placed in another hat. covered in like manner. The hats were then well shaken, of paper was then drawn from the hat containing the names, and one from the hat containing the numbers, and the result noted, this process was continued until all were drawn with the following result, viz.
