



Plats #313 and #314 pertain to the same tract of land containing 3,214 acres surveyed for Central Railroad and Bank Company in 1879. This is one of the largest areas plotted and is recorded in the Office of Probate Court, Louisville, GA in Plat Book 6 on pages 38 and 39. (These two pages were reduced, then scotch taped together to form the above.) Note that Johnson County bounds on the south and Emanuel County bounds on the east. I have plotted this plat on pages 62 and 71 of the book. The same land was owned by Joseph Oliphant, Louis Lampp and Elijah Hudson in 1837 and Everett Wells in 1836 as shown on pages 62 and 71 in Volume One. Note that the Old Sunbury Road (misspelled as Sunberry Road) is on the south line of Plat #313. For a description of the Old Sunbury Road, refer to Volume One, pages 8, 52, 98, 99, 100, and 125. Plat #314 shows Ohoopee Road (misspelled as Ohoopy Road). For references to Ohoopee Road in Volume One, refer to pages 62, 71, 779, and 791.
