

Georgia 3 In the name of God, Amen:
Joseph M. Livingston County 3 I, Joseph M. Livingston being of sound and disposing mind and memory but feeble in body, do make, publish and declare the following to be my only true last will and testament.

Item 1st I direct that my just debts be paid, and my body buried in a decent manner suitable to my circumstances in life.

" 2nd I give and bequeath all my property both real and personal to my wife and children and direct that it be kept together by my Executrix until my youngest child becomes of age, unless my wife should marry or die before that time, in which case, the property to be sold and divided share & share alike among the surviving members of my family.

" 3rd I direct that in case one or more of my Daughters should marry before my Estate is settled according to the second Item of this Will, my Executrix may give to said Daughter or Daughters some furniture or stock which can be spared from the place, or any reasonable sum of money from the proceeds of the crop of that or any previous year after my decease, which amount shall be charged against Daughter or Daughters in the settlement of my Estate.

" 4th I request that my Executrix manage to the best advantage for the Younger Children, and give them the benefit of all the Education she can from the proceeds of the farm.

" 5th I hereby appoint my wife H. C. Livingston my Executrix to carry out the provisions of this my Will.
