 the Estate both real and personal of said deceased, which
 have or shall come to the hands, possession or knowledge of
 the said William Spires, or unto the hands or possession of

 unto be required, and such Estates do well and truly Admin-

 void, else to remain in full force.

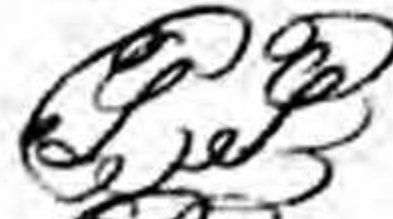
