I give recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God who gave it and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent and christian like manner suitable to my circumstances and condition resting in the expectation of the same through and with the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ and as touching such estate where with it has pleased God to bless me in this life

I give devise and dispose of in the following manner and to wit

My first it is my will and desire that all my just debts be paid without delay to my Creditors as there will be necessity for me to say also I give and bequeath to my said wife Elizabeth Smith (being) together one half Daniel Pauls son & Pauls Lucy Pauls and Mary Pauls the following property viz one third of my land including my present residence three negroes I have a man called a swain and a dog a house with as much pasture and other furniture plantation tools and stock of all kind as my wife Elizabeth Pauls my said son Daniel Pauls and my said daughter Elizabeth Pauls property to remain in the hands of my said wife Elizabeth Pauls during her natural life and then to be equally divided amongst my said son Daniel Pauls the said Elizabeth Pauls and my said daughter Elizabeth Pauls being one also I give and bequeath to my said wife Elizabeth Pauls the children of said Elizabeth Pauls being one Daniel Pauls Elizabeth Pauls Rebecca Pauls Sarah Pauls Anna Pauls Lucy Pauls and Mary Pauls to be equally divided amongst them all the residue of my estate both ^{personal} and real personal to be delivered to them and there ^{to be} received and kept as a destination
