State of Georgia } In the name of God Amen: I Charles  
Johnson County Conway of said State and county knowing  
that life is uncertain at all times I deem it right & proper both  
as respects my family and myself that I should make a disposition  
of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me,  
do therefore make this my last will and testament hereby revoking  
all others heretofore made by me

1st - I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and  
Christian like manner suitable to my circumstances and condition  
in life. my soul I trust shall return to God who gave it as I hope  
for eternal salvation through the merits of the blessed Lord and  
Saviour Jesus Christ.

2nd - I desire and direct that all my just debts be paid without  
delay by my Executors herein after mentioned, as I am unwilling  
my creditors should be delayed in their rights especially if there  
is no need for delay.

3rd - I give to my beloved wife Mary E. Conway after my  
just debts are all paid: All that may remain of my worldly ef-  
fects that I shall be possessed with at the time of my death for  
her own proper use & benefit & for the support of all of my & her  
lawful heirs that may be minors during her natural lifetime

4th - I desire & direct that immediately after the death of  
the said Mary E. Conway there be an equal division of  
whatever may remain of my worldly effects between my sons  
& daughters, heirs of the said Mary E. Conway, Charles Jr.  
James 216, William 31, Asa D. Abigail & Elizabeth Jr. &  
Conaway

5th - I hereby constitute & appoint my beloved wife Mary E.  
Conaway executrix, and my worthy friend Jacobus Lewis  
executor of this my last will & Testament
