 Georgia, } In the name of God Amen I
 Johnson County } Martin of State & County aforesaid
 being of sound mind and memory
 and considering the uncertainty of this frail and
 transitory life do therefore make ordain public
 and declare this to be my last Will & Testament
 hereby revoking any and all other here before made
 by me--

Item 1st I desire my body be buried in a decent and
 Christianlike manner my soul will I trust
 return to God who gave it,

Item 2nd I desire that my burial expences and all other
 just debts be at once paid by my Executor here
 in after named

Item 3rd I desire that my faire negroes Tom Ellice Sam
 & Patti and also all my perishable property
 be sold on twelve months credit by my
 Executors and the proceeds of such sale be
 divided among my Children & Grand Children in
 such way & manner as set forth in items 4 & 5th

Item 4th I give and devise unto the legal children of my
 Son Sadprey Martin if to be found, in trust and
 care of William H. Martin for them the sum of
 Two Thousand Dollars If they the children be not
 found then said sum to given them to revert to
 my estate & be equally divided between my children
 & Grand children as named in item 5th

Item 5th I desire that all the rest of my estate of which I die
 possessed be equally divided share and share alike
 between my children William Martin Eli Martin
 Catharine Martin Mary Martin & Sarah Lyon, wife
 of Charles H. Lyons, and my Grand children William
 & Webb Joseph Webb and Lucinda & Webb children
 of my Daughter Elizabeth & William & Webb.
 I wish my son William Martin to have a head
 and quarters turn as the rest has had their own

Item 6th I hereby appoint my worthy friend William
 H. Martin and my Son in Law Charles H.
 Lyons Executors to this my last Will & Testament
