Be it known } In the name of God amen  
Emmanuel County I Henry Pullen of the State  
of Georgia Emanuel County  
being in a bad state of Health bed of a perfect  
mind and memory thanks be given to God  
walking into mind the mortality of my body and  
knowing that it is appointed unto all men once  
to die do make and ordain this my last will  
and testament that is to say principal and  
first of all I give and bequeath recommend my  
Sale in to the hands of Almighty God that with  
it and my body I recommend to the earth to  
be buried in a decent Christian burial at the  
discretion of my executors and friends and to  
teaching such worldly estate to hear with it  
has pleased God to bless me with in this  
life I give devise and dispose of in the  
following manner and form to wit

First I give my half estate to be sold  
at publick sale by the executors time and place

and on such terms as my executors may lawfully determine and out of the proceeds of which I wish all of my just debts to be paid and the remainder I dispose of as follows to wit first I give to my named negro man Peter his maintenance during the remainder of his life for which my executors is to make provisions also I give to my Sister Pheriby Williams five Dollars also the remainder of my estate I give to be divided in five equal shares to be paid to the families of my five brothers and sisters to wit one share to be paid to the children of my Sister Pheriby Williams of her first Husband John Miles to be equally divided between said children and share to be paid to and equally divided between the children of my late brother Thomas Pullen one share to be paid to my brother Moses Pullen one share to be paid to the children of my late Sister Margaret Mason to be equally divided of said Margaret to the executors of her husband William Mason and any other of his children and heirs and share to be paid to the children of my late Sister Mary Hicks to be equally divided between the children of said Mary to the executors of her husband or any other of his heirs and do hereby make and ordain James Hicks my sole executor to this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby entirely disallow Revoke and disannul all and every other former testaments wills legacies bequest executed by me in any wise before named Will or before death ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and testament in witness whereof I have put unto set my hand an Seal this eighth day of April AD and thousand eight hundred and Thirtieth year the names on the first page to be equally divided amongst Chas. Shuck and wife and expunged he four signed signed pronounced and delivered in presents of
