to educate her I also give her and her heirs a negro
girl named Mary and her increase & desire that if
she Lucinda & Webb should die leaving no child or
children that said negro Mary and her increase
revert to my estate and be disposed of and said amo-
unt equally divided between my Sons William John
& Elie

Item 2^d I give and desire unto my Son Giles & Webb
Two Hundred Dollars a year to be paid annally for his
Support by my Executors herein after named
and I request & desire that after one or two years
trial they find Two Hundred Dollars not
adequate to his Support that he be allowed more
as I certainly wish him kindly treated & well
Taken care of

Item 3^d

Halland Wright Will

I desire that the Sum of twenty Five Dollars a year be given my old negro Man Charles to be paid him annully also that Five Dollars a year be allowed and paid annully to my negro woman Clarissa They have been good and faithful servants and I desire they receive from my estate The amount given annully

Item 4th

I desire that all my negroes as also other property be appraised & equally divided between my Sons William John & Eliza and at the death to go to their Children I wish in the division of my negroes my Son Eliza to take the following ones at appraisement prices namely London Luke & his wife Millar & their three Children Sam Dick & Son I do not wish one of my negroes sold but that they be taken by my Sons as above specified

Item 5th

I hereby constitute and appoint my beloved Sons William & John & Eliza & with my Executors to this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I the said Halland Wright have set my hand & seal this 19 day of July 1857
