

# Mary Ennis Will

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State of Georgia In the name of God Amen I Mary Johnson County Ennis of said State and County being of advanced age and in bad health of Body and knowing that I must shortly depart this life deemed Right and proper that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind Providence has blessed me do therefore make this my last will and Testament here by revoking all others heretofore made by me.

1st First I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner My Soul I shall return to God with God who gave it as I hope for Eternal Salvation through the merits and atonement of the precious Lord And I favour Jesus Christ

2nd Second I desire and direct that all my just debts paid by my Executor herein after affidavit be Thirdly Also I give and bequeath to my Son William P. Ennis my Best Bed and Bed Side one sheet Counter passe bedgilt two Pillows and cases Two tubs and one Pail and one Axe

Fourthly Also I give to the family of my Son James P. Ennis all my Chairs one Table and Spicery without a lid and one Lid iron

Fifthly Also I give to my Daughter Mary Hart the remainder of my Bed Clothes after taking out those hereof and those hereafter disposed of my Chest or writing apparel two water Buckets one Hand top or Spicery with a lid one pot one China plate one looking glass one Barrel and my wheel and Cards

Sixthly Also I Give to my Grand daughter Elizabeth Ann Ennis Daughter of my deceased Daug her Elizabeth Ennis one Bed furnished as the one bequeathed above to my Son William P. Ennis Three Skillet one Sugar Dish three plates and three Bowls

Seventh Also I give the Balance of my Estate to be divided into four equal shares one share to be given to my Son William P. Ennis one share to the family of my Son James P. Ennis one & share to myself Hart the other share to my Grand Daughter named above Elizabeth Ann Ennis

Eighth Also I hereby constitute and appoint John A. Hill Executor of this my last will and Testament this April 16th 1864
