

Mary Ennis' Will

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State of Georgia In the name of God Amen I Mary Johnson County Ennis of Said State and County being of advanced age and in bad health of Body and knowing that I must shortly depart this life deem it Right and proper that I should make a disposition of the property with which a kind providence has blessed me do therefore make this my last will and Testament true by revoking all others hitherto made by me

- 1st First I desire and direct that my body be buried in a decent and Christian like manner My Soul I trust shall return to Rest with God who Gave it as I hope for Eternal Salvation through the merits and atonement of the blessed Lord And I favour Jesus Christ
- 2d Second I desire and direct that all my just debts paid by my Executor herein after appointed
- 3th Thirdly Also I give and bequeath to my Son William P. Ennis my Best Bed and Bed Stead one sheet Counterspane bed quilt two Pillows and Case two tubs and one Pail and one Axe
- 4th Fourthly Also I give to the family of my Son James H. Ennis all my chairs one Table one Spider without a lid and one Chidion
- 5th Fifthly Also I give to my Daughter Mary Hart the mainder of my Bed Clothes after taking out those hitherto and those here after disposed of my Chest or wardrobe apparel two water Buckets one Band box one Spider with lid one pot one china plate one looking glass one Barrel and my wheel and Cards
- 6th Sixthly Also I give to my Granddaughter Elizabeth Ann Ennis Daughter of my deceased Daughter Eliza Ennis one Bed furnished as the one bequeathed above to my Son William P. Ennis one Dress Dresser and Skillet one sugar Dish three plates and three Bowls
- 7th Seventh Also I give the Balance of my Estate to be divided into four Equal shares one share to be given to my Son William P. Ennis one share to the family of my Son James H. Ennis one share to Mary Hart and the other share to my Grand Daughter named above Elizabeth Ann Ennis
- 8th Eighth Also I hereby constitute and appoint John Apline Executor of this my last will and Testament
