State of Georgia (In the name of God Amen
Johnson County) I Willis Johnson of said State and
County having to leave and go into service I dont know when
I ever will return but of sound and disposing mind and
memory demit right and proper both as respects my
family and my self that I should make due provision
of the property with which a kind Providence has
blessed me I do therefore make this my last Will and
Testament hereby revoking and annulling all others by
me heretofore made.

First - I desire and direct that my body be buried in
a decent and Christian like manner suitable to the
circumstances and condition in life my soul
I trust shall return to rest with God who gave it
as I hope for salvation through the merits and
atone ment of the blessed Lord and Saviour
Jesus Christ -

Secondly I desire that all my just debts be
paid without delay by my Executor herein
after named and appointed.

Thirdly I Give bequeath and devise to my be-
loved wife Mary Johnson all my lands all my
Stock in Horses Cattle & Hogs and all my farm
ing tools and all the household furniture
and every thing that belongs to me

Fourthly I hereby constitute and appoint
my wife Mary Johnson executrix of this
my last Will and Testament this July 1864
