of Johnson State of Georgia being of

being desirous to settle my worldly affairs
whereof I have strength so long as I live to make and
publish this my last will and testament
hereby revoking all wills by me heretofore
made and I first I commend my Soul
to God who made it and my body I desire
to be buried in a decent like manner and
my worldly estate I dispose of as follows

First

I desire that all my property, both real
and personal be kept together and managed
to the best advantage for the mutual benefit
of my beloved wife, wife Sarah Pyner and
and also my dear son George M. Pyner also my
dear son John M. Pyner until my youngest
son John Pyner arrives to the age of twenty
and 6 years of age then all my property both
real and personal to be equally divided between
my beloved wife and my two sons

And I do further constitute and appoint
George Rowland and my beloved wife
Sarah my executors of this my last will and
testament

In witness whereof the said Wilson
Pyner to the said wife Sarah and as
witnesses she and her son have set my
hand and seal this 10th June 1861
