State of Georgia In the name of God Amen
I, William G Carr being of sound
and disposing mind and being disposed to settle
my worldly affairs while I have strength to do so
do hereby make and ordain this to be my last Will and
testament hereby revoking all Wills heretofore
made by me

First I do desire that my body be decently
buried

that my just debts all be paid
Thirdly that the remainder of my worldly
affairs I give and bequeath to my beloved
daughter A Harity Carr for her lawful
proper use

Fourthly I appoint William Euggan my
my Executor in this my last Will
and Testament

signed sealed and delivered in the presence
of this 1st of May 1861
