State of Georgia I do in the name of Jones County Georgia Wills 1809-1835
Jones County I Bedell being in a sound state of health,
but in perfect mind & memory & knowing that it is
appropriate for man to die, have thought fit to make
this my last will & testament (to wit) I term I give to my
beloved wife Rhoda the tract of land I now live on, being no. 141. in the 9th district during her natural life
& then to return to my estate. I also give to my
wife Rhoda Bedell two negroes Ned & Linda to her, her
heirs & assigns forever. Item, I give to my beloved son
Abraham Bedell a half lot of land no. 148 in the 9th
district, also Sam & Lettuce to him his heirs & assigns
forever. Item, I give & bequeath to my beloved son
Charles Bedell the one other half of the above lot no.
148 of land & Jess & Amy to him & his ^{heirs &} assigns forever
Item, I give to my beloved daughter Nancy, forda
& Moses & as soon as my notes and accounts can be
collected, for my executors to purchase an other likely
negroe girl to her, her heirs & assigns forever. Item, I
give & bequeath to my beloved daughter Polly Bedell three
negroes, (to wit) Stephen, Click & Liza to her, her heirs
& assigns forever. Item, Will that my wife have all
my stock of horses, cattle, hogs & sheep, my household
& kitchen furniture, with all my plantation tools for
the support & educating my children, & as they become
of age for them to have an equal share of the above
household & kitchen furniture & stock with my
wife having her equal part, for this division to take
place as they shall marry off or become of age. Item,
I will & bequeath to my daughter Betsey Smith to
have an equal share of the dividends of the Estate
coming to me from Dr. Charles Smith deceased
of Green County with the property already given of to
her & her heirs forever. Item I will that all the
above lands & negroes with every other article of my
property be & in the hands of my wife & be together
until my heirs shall marry, or become of age
& then for them to be posses'd of their property agree
ably to the above. Item I will & ordain that my
loved wife Rhoda Bedell, and my brother

Bedell & Peter Taylor my lawfunders, witness to this
my last Will & testament this day of January in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & fourteen.

My Will is that Isabella Halstead my wife shall occupy
& enjoy all the property tenable or personal that shall
be in my possession at my death; that she shall be
sole & only Executrix with liberty from me to do & act
as she thinks proper during her lifetime, at her de-
cease the residue of the property that I may die pos-
sessor of shall go to my children share & share alike. I
hereby give freedom to Prince my slave at the death of
my wife Isabella with whom he must serve until
her decease. In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand & affixed my seal this twenty seventh day
of August 1814, And of the Independence of U. S. 39
