thanks be given unto God calling to mind the mortality of my Body & knowing it is appointed for all men once to die, do make & ordain this my last Will & testament. That is to say principally & first of all. I recommend my Soul unto the hands of Almighty God, that gave it; And my Body I recommend to the earth, from whence it came. And as touching my worldly estate, wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life. I give, devise & dispose of the same in the manner following Viz. I give & bequeath to Nancy my beloved Wife all the property which I may be possessed of at my decease together with all my household Goods & debts & moveable effects, also all & singular my lands & tenements by her freely to be possessed & enjoyed during her life, or widowhood. And I do hereby utterly disavow, revoke & disannul all & every other former Testaments, Wills, Legacies, bequests & Executors by me in any wise before named. Willed, & Bequeathed, Ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last Will & testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 26th day of July eighteen hundred & twelve.
