ward Cary my weeding hoe. I Item, I give + bequeath  
to my well beloved son Robert Cary + Jonathan Cary  
all my ready money + all monies due me that has  
not been otherwise <sup>disposed</sup> of after paying my funeral ex-  
pense + all other charges <sup>that</sup> may necessarily occur on  
the settling of my estate. I Item I do appoint Mitchell  
Burford + Daniel Melson my sole Executors to my last

I in the name of God, Amen, I Abraham Eiland of  
the State of Georgia + County of Jones, being very  
old + weak in Body, but of perfect mind + memory,

thanks be given unto God calling in mind the mortality of my Body + knowing it is appointed for all men once to die, do make + ordain this my last Will + testament. That is to say principally + first of all. I recommend my soul unto the hands of Almighty God, that gave it; And my Body I recommend to the earth, from whence it came. And as touching my real estate, wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life. I give, devise + dispose of the same in the manner following Viz. I give + bequeath to Nancy my beloved Wife all the property which I may be possessed of at my decease together with all my household Goods + debts + moveable effects, also all + singular my lands + tenements by her freely to be possessed + enjoyed during her life, or widowhood. And I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke + disannul all + every other former testaments, Wills, Legacies, bequests + Executors by me in any wise before named Willed, + bequeathed, Ratifying + confirming this + no others to be my last Will + testament. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand + seal this 26<sup>th</sup> day of July eighteen hundred + twelve.
