that it hath been pleased God to take me with I
give and dispose of follows, First I recommend my
Soul unto God, my Body to be decently buried. Item,
I give & bequeath unto my beloved Grand Daughter
Rebecca King as follows, one Bed & Steeds & furniture,
one Cow & Calf and the increase thereof. 2 I term,
I give & bequeath unto my beloved Son John Blalock
the Negroe Woman named Mary, and one Heifer
called Fine. 3 I term, my Will & desire is that my
Negroe Man named Anthony shall be set free

and have all his property sold up to him on his paying
into my Estate the sum of three hundred & fifty dollars.
Fourthly & lastly my Will desire is that my Estate real &
personally be equally divided amongst my Children namely
June Blalock, John Blalock, Rachel Park, Mary Bell wife of
Bailey Bell, also I do appoint James Blalock, & John Blalock
my Executors to the above Will. August the 12th 1813.

William R. Allen's Will.

In the name of God, Amen, I William R. Allen of the
County of Jones & State of Georgia being very sick & weak
in Body, but of perfect mind & memory thanks be
given to God, and as touching such worldly estate
wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this
life with, I give devise & dispose of the same in the
following manner & form. First, It is my Will &
desire that all my personal property together with
my land shall be sold at publick sale giving twenty
months credit taking bonds bearing interest from
the date (except such property as wife wants for the
support of the family) and after these bonds are col-
lected together with the accounts which are due
me at this time I wish the money laid out to the
best advantage in likely young increasing Negro,
which negroes will then be at the disposal, or
management of my executors for the use of my
widow & it is also my Will & desire that my son James
