Georgia I Ambrose Edwards of the State County aforesaid
Jones County being weak of body tho in perfect mind and mem-
ory and knowing it is once appointed for all men once to die
doth make and ordain this my last will and Testament.

I term first I give and bequeath to my beloved sonne his exec-
utors Will Book B - the original will reads, ("negro woman" don't her
freedom) and appoint my son John Edwards her Guardian dur-
ing her life time and ten acres of land for her to live on
her life time adjoining of Coke and John Edwards. Secondly
I give to my beloved daughter Sarah Lewis five dollars I
give and bequeath to the heirs of my daughter Sarah Lewis
body and equal proportion of my estate among the rest of my
children. I term the third I give and bequeath to my beloved
daughter Elizabeth Bowen and equal part of my estate among
the rest of my children I term the fourth I give and bequeath
to my beloved daughter Charity Campbell and equal part
of my estate among the rest of my children I term the fifth
I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Nancy Lewis and
equal part of my estate with the rest of my children I term the
sixth I give and bequeath to my beloved son William Edwards
and equal part of my Estate with the rest of my children
I term the seventh I give and bequeath to my beloved son John Ed-
wards, and equal part of my estate with the rest of my chil-
dren and lastly I wish at the expiration of the year for all
my real and personal estate to be sold that has not been
then away previously and an equal distribution to take place
to agent and or claim John Edwards my only Executor
and witness and testamentee Mrs Watson widow I have

hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty fourth day of February in the year of our Lord 1823.

Spencer Owens Will.

George I in the name of God Amen. I Spencer Owens of Jones County & the County and State aforesaid being in bad health but preserving my common mind and judgment and calling to mind the mortality of my body and the uncertainty of life do hereby make this instrument of writing as my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say first I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gives me existence, and my body to a Christian decent burial at the discretion of my Executors who I perceive to nominate and appoint.

First: I give to my Daughter Sarah Sharp one Dollar

2nd: I give to my daughter Mary Bonner one Dollar

3rd: I give to my son Peter Owens one Dollar

4th: I give to my son Jonathan Owens one Dollar

5th: I give to my Daughter Elizabeth Cooper a certain Dark colored cow & her calf a kind of black color

6th: I give to my son Samuel Owens a certain black cow and her calf of pieded color and a feather bed and furniture and one half of the tract of Land whereon I now live also one novel bed

7th: I give to my son Spencer Owens June the other half the land whereon I now live

8th: I give to my grandsons David Cooper a Bushel
