Benjamin Ledbetter's Will

In the name of God Amen.

I Benjamin Ledbetter being in my proper mind and mem-
ory calling into mind the mortality of my body and know-
ing that is appointed for all men to die do make and or-
der this my last Will and Testament first I give and bequeath
unto my daughter Martha one bed and furniture.

Second I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah one
bed and furniture.

Third I give and bequeath unto my son William one
Horse bridle and saddle when my Executors see proper
for him to receive said horse.

Fourth I leave a negro man Harry to be left with my Ex-
ecutor for the education of my children to be disposed of as
they see proper till they come to the age of twenty one and
then which ever of my said children will give the most
for said negro Harry is to have him.

Fifth I leave Rebekah and her child Albert and lot and
Middy to be disposed of by the Executors as they see proper
at public or private sale and also my tract of land to be
sold in the same way by said Executors, and all my
Stock of Horses and cattle and Hogs and household and
kitchen furniture and plantation tools to be sold at pub-
lic auction and to be equally divided betwixt my daughter
Martha Ann Sarah and my son John after all my just
debts are paid I do hereby appoint and Ordain
