

(Charity Spencer's Will) Wilkes County, Georgia Wills
1809-1835

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In the name of God amen. I Charity Spencer of the County of Jones & State of Georgia widow Being of sound mind & memory but weak and infirm in bodily strength, and calling to mind the frailty of Human nature & the uncertainty of this life do make and ordain this to be my last will & Testament. I hereby I commit my body to be decently interred with the solemnities of the Church and my spirit to god who gave it with a hope of a blessed immortality beyond the grave through the mediation of our Saviour Jesus Christ who redeemed us by his precious blood. Item I give and bequeath to my daughter Matilda Hill one negro wench named Eddy & Her son Charley with her increase to her and the heirs of her body and should she die without issue then and in that case it goes to her husband I also give my said daughter Matilda one man sold together with a bed and furniture now in her possession. Item I give and bequeath to my daughters Mary and Elizabeth two negro fellows named Warrin & May together with all my personal property at the time of my decease which I wish to be sold as soon my Executors can possibly do it & for them to purchase two negro girls for my said daughters Mary & Elizabeth and for the balance of the said sales to be put at interest & to be paid them when they shall arrive to the age of twenty one or sooner at the discretion of my Executors and should either of them die without issue or before they come of legal age then the survivor of the two is to have the entire of the property of the deceased and dispose of it as she thinks proper. I also give them one bed & furniture each which is not to be sold with my other personal property the whole of my estate to be subject never the less to the payment of all debts & demands against it. As Executors of this my last will & Testament hereby revoking all others. I do nominate and appoint Roger McCarthy of Jones County and William Carter of Baldwin County both of the State of Georgia my witnesses whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 16th day of March Eighteen hundred & fifteen. land household and kitchen furniture & also all my
negroes (to wit) Grace Sall Mary Patt Stephen & Hermod
and all my stock & plantation tools that is to say my
estate both real and personal during her natural life
or widowhood. 2 Item at my wifes decease I give my
Land to my son Darin Magee also all the stock house-
hold and kitchen furniture one negro woman Grace one
negro woman called Sall & her increase one negro
boy called Stephen one negro girl called Pate. 3 Item
at my wifes death decease I give to my daughter Char-
lotte Dloyd one negro girl called Mary 4 Item at my
wifes decease I give to my son Richard one negro
boy called Hermod. 5 Item at my wifes decease I give
unto my son Milby Magee one dollar. 6th Item at
my wifes decease I give unto my son James Magee
one dollar. 7 Item at my wifes decease I give unto
my son Josiah Magee one dollar - 8 Item At my wifes
decease I give unto my daughter Rachel Taylor one dol-
lar 9 Item At my wifes decease I give unto my son
Joseph Magee one dollar. 10 Item At my wifes decease
I give unto my daughter Sarah Caldwell one dollar.
