In the name of God Amen I Charles McLamore of the State of Georgia and County of Jones being very sick and weak in body but of sound mind and memory being fully assured that it is appointed for all men once to die do make this my last will and testament in manner and form as follows First I cheerfully give up my soul and body to Almighty God who gave it. Secondly that all my just debts be paid such worldly estate as it has been pleased god to bless me with I give and dispose of in the following manner. I turn for the gods will favour and affection I bear to Elizabeth McLamore John William James Rebeckah Jones Pleasant Jesse and William McLamore wife and children of James M^c Lamore Decd. This my last will and desire is that my whole estate shall be equally divided between the above named persons Thirdly it is my will and desire that William McLamore and James McLamore should act as executors to this my last will and testament I hereby

vest them with full power and authority to collect all that may be due to my estate after my decease I do assign this as my last will and testament this tenth day of September one thousand eight hundred and fifteen.

America and as an Inhabitant of the County and State
first above written do make ordain and declare my
last will and testament to be as follows, to wit, I give
to my son Charles P Hansford three negroes (to wit)
Celia, Ralph and Nelly. To my daughter Sally Harri-
son a negro boy named Moses to my son William
a negro boy named Jack. To the heirs of my daughter
Elizabeth by her present husband Henry D Stone a neg-
ro woman named Sam and her issue to my daugh-
ter Matilda a negro boy named Peter to my son George
I have already given three hundred dollars in place of
a negro boy named Jesse which boy I once designed
for him to my daughter the heirs of my daughter Pol-
by by her present husband Geo P Ryan) I give a negro
girl named Mary to be delivered to said heirs at the dis-
cretion of my wife. To my son John a boy named
Levin, and to my beloved wife I give during her wid-
owhood the balance of my negroes and the tract of land
whereon I now reside and in case she should mar-
ry my will and desire is that she retain during her
life a negro woman named Jude and the land to
be retained by my son John and the negroes to be
