Rebecca former Pleasant Jesse and William Mc-  
lamore wife and children of James McLamore Deed  
This my last will and desire is that my whole estate  
shall be equally divided between the above named per-  
sons Thirdly it is my will and desire that William  
McLamore and James McLamore should act execu-  
tors to this my last will and testament I have done

vest them with full power and authority to collect all that may be due to my estate after my decease I do assign this as my last will and testament this tenth day of September one thousand eight hundred and fifteen.

Morgan County 3 Hansford a citizen of the United States of  
America and as an inhabitant of the County and State  
first above written do make ordain and declare my  
last will and testament to be as follows To wit I give  
to my son Charles P Hansford three negroes (to wit)  
Celia, Ralph and Nelly To my daughter Sally Harris  
son a negro boy named Moses To my son William  
a negro boy named Zach. To the heirs of my daughter  
Elizabeth by her present husband Henry D Stone a neg-  
ro woman named Sam and her issue to my daugh-  
ter Matilda a negro boy named Peter To my son George  
I have already given three hundred dollars in place of  
a negro boy named Jessie which boy I once designed  
for him To my daughter the heirs of my daughter Pol-  
ly by her present husband Jno P Ryan I give a negro  
girl named Mary to be delivered to said heirs at the dis-  
cretion of my life To my son John a boy named  
Loring and to my beloved wife To give during her life-  
time the balance of my negroes and the tract of land  
whereon I now reside and in case she should leave  
my will and desire is that she retain during her  
life a negro woman named Jude and the land to  
be my son John and the negroes to be
