pointed for all men to die do make and ordain this my
last will and testament and what wordly goods it
hath pleased Almighty God to bless me with I dispose of
them in the following manner- (To wit) I item I give
and bequeath unto my beloved wife Nelly Magee my
land household and kitchen furniture + also all my
negroes (to wit) Grace Sall Mary Patt Stephen + Hermod
and all my stock + plantation tools that is to say my
estate both real and personal during her natural life
or widowhood. 2 I item at my wifes decease I give my
land to my son Davis Magee also all the stock house-
hold and kitchen furniture one negro woman Grace one
negro woman called Sall + her increase one negro
boy called Stephen one negro girl called Pate. 3 I item
at my wifes death decease I give to my daughter Char-
lotte Lloyd one negro girl called Mary 4 I item at my
wifes decease I give to my son Richard one negro
boy called Hermod. 5 I item at my wifes decease I give
unto my son Milby Magee one dollar. 6th I item at
my wifes decease I give unto my son James Magee
one dollar. 7 I item at my wifes decease I give unto
my son Josiah Magee one dollar - 8 I item at my wifes
decease I give unto my daughter Rachel Taylor one dol-
lar. 9 I item at my wifes decease I give unto my son
Joseph Magee one dollar. 10 I item at my wifes decease
I give unto my daughter Sarah Calwell one dollar.

Georgia } I Jacob Dennis Senr of the state and County

mind and memory and being desirous to settle my
worldly affairs whilst I have strength and capacity so to
do, making and ordaining and publish this my last and
testament hereby revoking and making void all former
wills by me at any time hereafter made. And first
and principally I commit my soul unto the hands
of my Creator who gave it and my body to the earth to be
interred in a decent Christian like manner at the dis-
cretion of my executors here in after named and as to
such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to
entrust me, I dispose of the same as followeth.

Item 1st I will and desire that all my just debts funer-
al and other expenses of my last illness be paid as
soon after my decease as conveniently can be.

Item 2^d I will and bequeath unto my son John Dennis
five negroes viz Aron Sam L. Dave, Bill and John.

Item 3^d I will and bequeath unto my son William
Dennis five negroes viz Lewis B. Dams Alexander

William & George. Item 4 I will and bequeath unto my
son Jacob Dennis five negroes viz Tom Jim Stephen
