Lastly I appoint my said beloved wife + my son in Law Ulrich Jones who is married to my Daughter Mary to be Executors to this my will and as hereby witness this to be my last will and testament revoking all others heretofore made in the presence of my very good friends Sarah Helton Charles Price + Robert Cunningham who I desire to witness the same in witness whereof I hereunto set my hand + seal this 6th day of February A.D. 1821.
