law, and divide it in this way, after all my debts if any, and
Expenses is paid let there be an Equal Division between my wife
Charlotte and my Brother Peter excepting my Brother William
to have one thousand dollars of my estate in my last will and
Testament given from under my hand and Seal, this the six-
teenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and thirty two

Last will and testament revoking all former Wills. In the first place I will and bequeath my soul to God who gave it, and my body to the Earth to be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors my next desire is that my beloved son John Jones shall have one lot of land drawn in my own name lying in the Eleventh district of Henry County known by lot No 3 (Eighty one) My next will and desire is that my Grand Daughters Elizabeth Jones and Malinda Jones shall have one counterpane each which is shortly to be woven by my son John Jones's wife, and also it is my wish that my daughter in law Fanny Jones shall have her first choice of my bed covers, and Mrs Mary White shall have the next choice. The balance of my Estate both real and personal to be sold and equally divided among all my legal heirs. My next desire is that my son John Jones should act as Executor of this my last will and testament. Signed Sealed and delivered in the presence of September the 17th A.D. 1827.
