Jacob Dennis Senior Will.

Georgia } I Jacob Dennis Senior of the State and County
Jones County aforesaid being in good sound and disposing
mind and memory and being desirous to settle my
worldly affairs whilst I have strength and capacity so to
do, making and ordaining and publishing this my last will and
testament hereby revoking and making void all former
wills by me at any time hereafter made. And first
and principally I commit my soul unto the hands
of my Creator who gave it and my body to the earth to be
buried in a decent Christian like manner at the dis-
cretion of my executors here in after named and as to
such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to
endue me, I dispose of the same as followeth.

Item 1st I will and desire that all my just debts funeral
and other expenses of my last illness be paid as
soon after my decease as conveniently can be.

Item 2nd I will and bequeath unto my son John Dennis
five negroes viz Aron Sam L. Dave, Bill and John

Item 3rd I will and bequeath unto my son William
Dennis five negroes viz. Lewis B. Dave Alexander
Wilson George - Item 4 I will and bequeath unto my
son Dennis five negroes viz Tom Jim Stephen

I sham and Milley - 5th I will and bequeath unto my daughter Rachel Armstrong Eight hundred dollars to be paid out of the first money adies from my land or stock.

I term 6 I will that Phillip Peter and Delph my plantation and all my land, stock of all kind with my household furniture plantation utensials be sold to the highest bidder at twelve months credit taking small notes with approved security and when collected and Eight hundred dollars paid is Rachel Armstrong then the balance to be equally divided between John Dennis William Dennis and Peter Dennis. I term 7 and lastly I nominate John Dennis William Dennis Peter Dennis and James Jones Esq. Executors of my last will and testament. I, witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 30th October 1816.
