that my present crop of cotton with all the stock that can
be spared be sold as soon as possible and the crop that
may be made the present year if the land can't be sold
and when the land is sold with all the stock and all debts
collected that is due me and all paid that is due from
me then it is my will that an equal division be made
between my beloved wife and heirs of my son James H.
my daughters Rebecca & Elizabeth Antioch and Jeremiah
with the following exceptions I give unto the children of my
son James a third part of my estate to be at his ser-
vice and use but the right never to be conveyed out of
their part and to his son my grandson Jesse Shadrack
the sum of five hundred dollars over and above and that
my daughter Rebecca have her proportion of my estate
in money and not to have any part of my negroes
and that my daughter Mary Liddell be held or allowed
an equal part in money with the rest of my children
after deducting five hundred dollars which it is calcu-
lated she has already received and it is my wish that
my executors do set their own discretion in employing
an overseer and keeping the stock making a crop
and dairy with and for my estate the present year as they
may think most to the benefit of the same and I do hereby
nominate and appoint my trustee friends Lazarus Battle
Luke Bond & see Mr Rivers Pope Edmund Love and John
Cook & Peter Wiche the sole executors of this my last will
and testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this tenth day of February in the
year of our Lord 1817. signed sealed and acknowledged in
