In the name of God Amen I John Finnie of the County of Jones
and the State of Georgia being in my perfect senses and
recollecting it is appointed for man once to die do make
and ordain this my last will and testament First I do
recommend my soul unto the hands of Almighty God
that gave it and my body to the earth to be buried with
decent Christian burial 1st Item I give and bequeath to my son
Arthur Finnie one hundred and ten dollars 2nd I give and
bequeath to the children of my son John Finnie (to wit)
Sarah and Ezekiel Finnie two dollars to each 3rd I
give and bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah Finnie
all the rest of my estate both real and personal during
her natural life or widowhood Then for said prop-
erty to be equally divided between the rest of my surviving
children I do also constitute and appoint my son Arthur
Finnie and my son Drury Finnie Executore to this
my last will and testament In witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand and seal this 27th day of
March 1815.
