I lend unto my beloved Wife Elizabeth Garret during her natural life, all the residue of my Estate consisting of household furniture, stock of every kind for her support during her life, and not any Vileful waste to be made of the same. Item, If any remainders of my Estate aforementioned after her death to be equally divided between my Son Robert Garret and Francis Barnes to them + their heirs forever. Item I give unto my beloved Son Jacob one dollar to him + his heirs forever. Item, I give unto my beloved daughter Nancy Sedlow one dollar to her + her heirs forever, and all other Wills or bequeaths I disannul + disallow.
