estate so as to affect the maintenance of my family to  
the best of my execution & I do hereby confirm what  
I have done in this my will and my son James

Smith and my Son William Smith and my Daughter Nancy Cook and my Daughter Sarah Hammont at the death of my wife Nancy Smith all my children except my two Sons Basell and James Smith to have each of them the value in money or property of land my said sons Basell and James Smith has already had and the balance of my property to be for the maintenance of my Son Henry during his natural life shoul'd he survive the death of his mother to be equally divided among all my children at his death & if he shoulk not survive the death of his mother to be equally divided at her death the property to be applied to the maintenance of my Son Henry in the best way & manner my executors may judge for his benefit And I do hereby constitute make and ordain my wife Nancy Smith my son John Smith Jr and my friend Abraham S. Wright my sole Executors of this my last will & testament And I do hereby utterly disallow re-nounce and disannull all and every other testament will legacies bequeathes and Executors by me in any wise before made or ratifying and confirming this and no other to be my last will & testament in In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand seal this Eighteenth day of March one thousand eight hundred and twenty six
