John Ward's Will.

Know all men by these present, that I John Ward of the State of Georgia Jones County calling to mind the certainty of death and the uncertainty of life, being weak in body but in perfect mind and memory have thought proper this sixth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty to make and ordain this my last will and testament.

1<sup>st</sup> That my just debts be paid from the sale of my present crop.

2<sup>nd</sup> I give to my wife Ridley Ward during her natural life or widowhood the third of the tract of land whereon I now live to be laid off in such a manner as to include the dwelling house, barn lot & cotton machine with the privilege of the wood land together with five negroes viz Sam, Molly, Dick Armstrong and Cynthia, two beds, & bedsteads, and furniture, two fine chests, side board, tables earthen ware and all the kitchen furniture and the sitting chairs, one bay mare and a sorrel horse colt, three herd choice cows and calves & one yoke over one cow and ten shoats fifteen hundred weight of pork for the ensuing year, seventy five barrels corn, thirty bushels wheat, three thousand weight of fodder, two plows, with three hoes to each and two pairs of gear complete.

3<sup>rd</sup> I give to my two sons John and Peatons Ward two thirds of the tract of land whereon I now live and at the death or marriage of their mother I give them the other third to be equally divided between them.

4<sup>th</sup> I give to my son Anderson Ward one dollar having already given him in land and money seven hundred and seventy five dollars which I consider to be a full share, though should he not be equal on a division of the Estate I wish him to be made equal with the rest.

5<sup>th</sup> The remaining part of my Estate to be sold to the highest bidder on a credit of twelve months and the money arising from the sales thereof to be equally divided betwixt my children Nancy Colter, Rubin Clements, Jacob

Sarah Clements, Anne Neasy, Martha Ward, Lucy L. Ward, and  
my two grand daughters Mary & Martha W. Harp, bodily heirs  
of my daughter Elizabeth Harp and first paying my daughter  
Martha and Lucy L. Ward, one hundred & fifty dollars each  
in consideration of property received by the others at the  
time of their marriage and at the death or marriage of  
my wife the property will'd to her (the land excepted) to be  
sold to the highest bidder, and the net proceeds  
coming from the sales thereof to be equally divided among  
my children as above named.

4<sup>d</sup> partly I do hereby appoint Ridley Ward Executive and  
Freeman and John S. Gailey my executors to this my last  
will & testament.

boy Jack & one girl Sarah & all the said Charlotte increase  
her posterity In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand,
