worldly affair do make and ordain this my last will and test-
ament to wit. Item 1st I give and bequeath unto my son Andrew
Comer to him and his heirs forever, all my negroes to wit
Phillis Brey Andrew Spence Rachel Matilda Estya about many
Adaline Caesar Lucy together with all my store of horse corn
hogs Corn fodder Cotton and all my furniture both house and
kitchen beds and other articles now in my possession including
utensils of every description also my interest in the bank lottery
I do hereby appoint Anderson Comer Executor of this my last
will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this the 15th day of March 1826.

Joseph Duckworth's Will

Georgia } In the name of God Amen I Joseph Duckworth of
Jones County } the County and State of Georgia and being feeble in body
and of declining mind and memory and knowing the uncertainty of life
and the certainty of death do make and ordain this my
last will and Testament. Item 1st I give and bequeath

unto my beloved wife Ann Duckworth my entire real Estate Com-
prising the tract whereon I now reside and 70 80 in the 12th dis-
trict of Monroe, No 35 in the 10th district of formerly Monroe now
Upson County during and for her natural life.

Item 2nd I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife as aforesaid
the following Negroes Dick Jack Corey, Sam Schmal ^{Samuel} Pinald Ann
Lety Betty Manning, Phelan and their increase for and during
his natural life the residue of my ~~residual~~ ^{personal} property consist-
ing of Stock household and kitchen furniture &c &c &c
I bequeath in like manner as aforesaid.

Item 3rd I give and bequeath unto Polly Gibson formerly Polly Dav-
idson and the legal heirs of her Body one negro man named
Bob and negro boy named Andy to them forever.

Item 4th I give and bequeath unto George M S Gibson Son of
William C and Polly Gibson a negro girl named Eliza to him
forever.

Item 5th I will and desire at the decease of my beloved wife Ann
as aforesaid, that the whole of my property both real and per-
sonal not herein especially bequeath + disposed of be sold and
the proceed thereof to be distributed in the following manner and
to the following persons to wit, To Frederick H. Heaver the sum of
Four hundred dollars. To John T. Pearson Son of John Pearson
the sum of four hundred dollars. To Patey Heaver formerly
Patey Stephens the sum of Five hundred dollars. To Polly
Gibson and her heirs as aforesaid one third of the remaining
balance undistributed inclusive of the two negroes herein
bequeathed. The balance remaining after the above dis-
tributions are made to be given and divided equally a-
mong my nephews then living to each and every one of them.

Item 6th I do moreover hereby appoint and constitute my
trustee and beloved friend John English and Warren
Jordan my Executors and my beloved wife my Executor
to execute this my last will and testament hereby revoking
and annulling all others heretofore made by me as
witness my hand and seal this 7th day of April 1827

Charles B. Bowen's Will.

I in the name of God Amen - I Charles B. Bowen of the County
of Jones & State of Georgia being weak in body but of sound
and disposing mind and memory and being desirous whilst
in possession of the same of disposing of such property as it
has pleased almighty God to bless me with I do make ordain
and publish this my last will & testament in relation
thereto:

First It is my will & desire that all my just debts be
paid as soon as possible and for that purpose I direct that
my negro fellows Charles, Moses, Michael & Thomas be ap-
propriated & set apart for the payment of all my just debts
and I request my Executors herein after named as soon
as it can conveniently be done after my decease to sell
said negroes either at public or private sale for the
best price that can be procured for them in cash and
the proceeds applied to the extinguishment of my debts and
in case any judgments shall be obtained against them my
Executors as such before said negroes shall be sold then
in that event I direct & require my said Executors to part
out said negroes as a sufficiency to satisfy such judgment
or judgments to be derived or to satisfy such judgment
or judgments as may be recovered against them in their
representative character of Executors and it is my will & desire
that should a surplus of the proceeds of the sales of said
negroes remain after the payment of all my just debts be
divided equally between my daughter Patsy Carter Glyn
and my son George I will and desire my
