Joseph Harrison's Will.

I Joseph Harrison of the County of Jones, and of the State
of Georgia being in a low state of health but sound in mind
and memory have thought proper to make this my last will
and testament. 1st I wish all my just debts paid out of the
crop that may be on hand at my decease and the balance of
my personal and real estate to remain in the possession of my
dear wife Charlotte Harrison during her natural life or wid-
owhood for the purpose of supporting her and the small children
and for the purpose of giving the children such an Education as
she may think proper, and further to be disposed of in the fol-
lowing manner viz: to be given to my sons William Robert
Whealy & Freely Joseph A and Lorenzo D Harrison as they be-
come of the age of twenty one, or married off to each the good
feather bed and furniture and one cow and Calf, also to my daugh-
ter Mary one good feather bed and One Cow and Calf.
2nd At the death of my wife Charlotte I wish to be given to my
daughter Mary one negro girl by the name of Biddy and in the

event that said girl should die before she receive her then one
of equal value to be given in her place and to my daughter Fanny
Davidson two hundred and fifty dollars and to James Middleton if he
should be living five hundred dollars.

3rd the balance of my estate both real and personal to be equally
divided between my sons George, William, Robert, Henry &
Filey Joseph R. and Lorenzo D. Harrison.

4th In the event of any one of the legatees dying before they
receive their appointed legacy, then said legacy to be equally
divided between the surviving legatees.

5th And lastly I nominate and appoint my dear wife Charlotte
Harrison and my sons George and William Harrison my execu-
trix and my executor to this my last will and testament.
