I in the name of God Amens I Joshua Harris Sen. of the State of Georgia and County of Jones being in good health and of a sound mind & memory do constitute and ordain this my last will Testament first recommending my soul to god that gave it and my body to the dust from whence it came and as to my worldly goods I dispose of as follows. I ten the 1st I give to my son Joshua Harris one negro woman and increase named Lucy one negro man named Abraham one boy by the name of David one boy the name of Peter one by the name of Sam and the land whereon I now live it containing Eighty Seven and one half acres of land be the same more or less it joining Rose & others & a part of a fraction on the Ocmulgee River And all the Stock of every kind Household & Kitchens furniture but if the said Joshua Harris Junr. Should die without issue then the above estate to be equally divided between James & Sally Harris Children I ten 2nd I give my daughter Nancy Green Child a negro woman

by the name of Tildy & her Increase, I also constitute and
ordain my trusty friends Joshua Harris Jones & James
Harris as Executors to this last will & Testament witness
whereof I have set my hand & seal this 29th January

ly estate as it has been pleased god to bless me
with I give and dispose of in the following man-
ner. I term for the gods will favour and affection
I bear to Elizabeth McLamore John Williams James
Rebeckah Jones Pleasant Jesse and William Mc-
lamore wife and children of James McLamore Deed.

Thus my last will and desire is that my whole estate
shall be equally divided between the above named per-
sons. Thirdly it is my will and desire that William
McLamore and James McLamore should act as execu-
tors to this my last will and testament I have
