I do hereby constitute and appoint my wife Susannah Manning to be my lawful whole & sole Executrix to this my last will & testament to do & perform all things for the best interest and benefit of my Children with the right of appointing an executor of this my last will and testament at her desire. It is my desire that if any of my servants will not be controlled by my Executrix that they be hired out to some person that will clothe and feed them well, either him or her.
