Comer to him and his heirs forever. all my negroes to wit
Phillis Enny Andrew Spencer Rachel Matilda Eliza Albert Mary
Adaline Caesar Lucy together with all my stock of horses cows
hogs Corn fodder Cotton and all my furniture both house and
kitchen beds and other articles now in my possession including
utensils of every description also my interest in the bank lottery
I do hereby appoint Anderson Comer Executor of this my last
will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and seal this the 10th day of March 1826.
