In the name of God Amen.

I Nancy Stephenson of Jones County and State of Georgia lying in a low state of Health but of sound mind and memory do make this and constitute this my last will and testament in manner and form following to wit in the first place I recommend my Soul to Almighty God who gave it and my Body to the dust from whence it was taken to be enter'd in or lain and second manners at the discretion of my Executors hereon after to be made.

Item 1<sup>st</sup> I give and bequeath unto Nancy Patrick my niece one bed and bedstead and cord one Bolster two Pillows three sheets three bed quilts, two pillow slips and foot Vallants woolen wheel one clock weel half dozen split bottom chairs one pine table one pair of weaving gears one Slay Shuttle temples and rake one table cloth and two towels one hand box two sugar boxes and all my crockery ware one coffee pot and a large tin bucket two iron pots one dutch oven and wire sifters and fifteen Dollars in money when the stock and growing crop is sold and that is all I intend for her.

Item 2<sup>nd</sup> I give and bequeath unto Jane Lipey my grand daughter one bed and bedstead and cord one bolster two pillows and two pillow slips three sheets two bed quilts one iron counterpane one trunk one slab one looking glass one dressing table and furniture one umbrella one pair of smoothing iron one pair of steel yard one small tin bucket two table cloths two towels one brass candle stick and fifteen Dollars in money. when the stock and growing crop is sold one Bridle one Slay one set of knives and forks and that is all I intend for her.

Item 3<sup>rd</sup> I give and bequeath unto Frances R. Borden one set of silver tea spoons one side saddle blanket and riding coat and I also want all my living stock of hogs and cattle and one sot mare and my crop and the balance of the household and kitchen furniture and plantation tools not above named all to be sold and all my just debts and funeral expenses paid and I also want the land if I should be fortunate enough to draw in the land lottery to be sold and all the money to be equally divided between Frances R. Borden and Beadia Lipey.

Item 4<sup>th</sup> I nominate and appoint my long friend Edward Wil- son his wife as Guardian to take Nancy Patrick and her property and I also nominate and appoint my long

friend Sylvester Harkins as Guardian for Jane Lipsey to take her  
and her above named property. And lastly I also nominate and  
appoint my loving Son Readin Borden my whole and sole Ex-  
ecutor to sell the above named property and to divide the money  
between the above named Frances R. Borden and Readin  
Lipsey to this my last will and testament signed sealed and  
delivered in the presence of us this the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of October in  
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two.

niture I also give and bequeath to my wife Eliza Ledbetter the following property namely the land on which I now live in the County of Jones - on the waters of Commissioners Creek and my negroes Perry Henry Sam Linny Amy + Jane with all their future issue to her the said Eliza during her natural life also to my wife Eliza Ledbetter all the stock of every descrip-  
tion Household and kitchen furniture of every description Plan-  
tations tools after all my debts are paid the land and her  
house and their future issue which I gave to my son
