4th My will further is that at my wife Elizabeth's death all the property above lent to her be sold and equally divided between all my children above named.

5th And lastly I constitute and appoint my two sons John and John Berry my Executors to this my last will, revoking all others by me made authorizing ^{them} to act in the best way in their judgment may seem best for the advancement of my estate: as witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this twenty fourth day of September in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty eight.
