Nehemiah Dunn's Will

In the name of God Amen, Nehemiah Dunn, of the State
of Georgia, and County of Jones, being weak of body but of
sound mind & memory hereby revoking all other wills, do
make and ordain this my last will & Testament in the man-
ner following (to wit)

I give 1st I think to my beloved wife Anna Dunn during
her natural life all that part of the tract of Land whereon
I now reside in the County aforesaid lying South of Shoal
Creek between said Shoal Creek Hog Creek & Cedar Creek to-
gether with the privileges of the mills and mill seats on said
Shoal creek up to high water mark on the other side. also
bound unto her my said wife Anna Dunn two negroes name-
ly Jack and Ritten and one black Horse with half the Stock
of Hogs and cattle that I may be in possession of at my
death and as much of my household & kitchen furniture
as she may think proper to retain and each of my mar-
ried children to be furnished with one horse and saddle
one bed & furniture and two cows and calves at birth.

ance of my stock and furniture at the time of their marrying or when needed.

Item 2^d It is my will that at the death of my beloved wife Anna Dunn the above named negroes Jack and Nitta together with the stock of Chattle Hoggs House hold and kitchen furniture to be sold and the money be equally divided between my daughters.

Item 3^d It is my will that the following negroes (To wit) March Dick, Amy, Lucy, Cesar Anderson, Philip, George, Adaline, Bob & Glick together with all those that I have let out in the hands of my children (To wit) Linda ^{Winn} Wiley Anna and her child William also Bill Lewis and Sam be at a proper time after my death collected together and appraised by three men who I shall hereafter name in this my will and to equally divided between each of my daughters agreeable to valuation (the value of the aforesaid Winn to be considered as having been given to my daughter Rebecca) allowing those who now have any of the said negroes in possession to Retain them at their valuation if they choose also any that I may hereafter let out to my children to be kept by those who have them at their valuation as aforesaid.

Item 4. I give unto my son Elijah A. Dunn the privilege of settling on and cultivating any part of that part of my land named in the first item of this will with the full use of the Saw Mill and timber on said tract during the natural life of his Mother with the Exception that she is to enjoy the free use of the plantation under cultivation the dwelling house and appertinances thereto the Grist Mill and Cotton Machines and that if my said son Elijah shall attend to & keep in repair the said Grist Mill he shall be entitled to one sixth part of the profits arising from the same and shall have a part in the use of the cotton Machine.

and at the death of her my said beloved wife Anna he my said son Elijah shall be vested in the full right and title to said land and premises upon his paying two thousand dollars in two equal annual instalments the first payment to be one year after the death of his Mother the said two thousand dollars to be equally divided between each of my daughters.

Item 5th it is my will that after my death all that part of the land of land whereon I now reside lying north of Shoat Creek (the width of the Shoat as far as high water mark excepted) situated in Walton County No 71 first district con-

taining two hundred and fifty acres to be sold at the discretion
of my Executors as they may deem most advantageous and the
proceeds equally divided between my daughters —
Item 6 It is my will that the money which is due to me
from William Wright in Columbia County be collected and my
Cotton now on hand be sold unless sold by myself and the
money applied to the payment of all my just debts after which
I wish one hundred and twenty five dollars to be paid to Joseph
Day one hundred dollars to James Calhoun and fifty dollars
to Samuel Winy it being the amount of money paid by
them for negroes which I let them have — also that if I or
my Executors should have to pay the amount of note for which
suit is instituted against me in favor of Patrick Calhoun for
bank of James Lock that then the same be deducted out of the
part that would otherwise go to my daughter Sarah Locke —
Item 7 I hereby authorize and appoint Peter Wyche Jesse McKemie
Pope & Miss Scarborough to value the negroes as named in
the third item and divide them by lot or otherwise to the best
advantage and my surplus that may be left after the above
named dispositions to be equally divided between my daughters
as aforesaid —

Item 8th I do hereby constitute and appoint my beloved wife
Anna Dunn Brenting and Joseph Day Executors to carry in
to effect this my Last Will and Testament —

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and af-
fixed my seal this Seventeenth day of April one thousand eight
hundred and twenty one.

Share & Share a Like I also Give unto my wife the Following
Negroes a fellow named Skiff & Fanny his wife also my large
boy Mare which said Negroes & Mare the Out Port and at her
death to do with them as she thinke proper or she may wish
I tem and Give to my Son Washington McFarlin the Negro Wo-
man named Phillis.

I tem and give to my Son Peter McFarlin a negro Girl by the
name of Charlot -

I tem & Give to my Son Aaron H. McFarlin a negro Fellow
named Ceaser -

I tem & Give unto my Son Harvey McFarlin a negro boy by
the name of Jim.

I tem & Give my daughter Martha W. McFarlin the negro Girl
named Annis & Mariah also a bay horse calle'd Lom & her
bed & furniture & trunks -

I tem & Give all my house hold & kitchen Furniture To my wife
& Sons to Peter Aaron H. & Harvey and my daughter Martha W.
McFarlin to be kept together for there mutual benefit so long
as they stay together and at the death of my wife for it to be
equally divided or sold and then divided share & share a Like
among my Sons Peter, Aaron H. & Harvey and my daughter
Martha W. McFarlin to them & their heirs for ever -
