+ by these present do make this my last will Viz: I resign my soul
to my heavenly maker how through the merits of my Dear Re-
deemer I hope for Salvation + my body to the Dust from whence it
came. I will and bequeath all my worldly Goods in the following
manner To wit —

I tem The Tract of Land and the Improvements thereon that I now
Reside on to my Loving wife and to my Sons Peter, Aaron and
Harvey McFarlin during the Life of my said Wife and at her death
to be Divided in my said Sons Peter, Aaron H. + Harvey McFarlin
Share + Share a Like I also leave unto my wife the Following
Negroes a fellow named Skiff + Fanny his wife also my large
boy Mare which said Negroes + Mare the Out Port and at her
death to do with them as she thinks proper or she may wish
I tem and Give to my Son Washington McFarlin the Negro Wo-
man named Phillis.

I tem and give to my Son Peter McFarlin a negro Girl by the
name of Charlot —

I tem + Give to my Son Aaron H. McFarlin a negro Fellow
named Ceaser —

I tem + Give unto my Son Harvey McFarlin a negro boy by
the name of Jim.

I tem + Give my daughter Martha W. McFarlin the negro Girl
named Annis + Mariah also a bay horse called Tom + her
bed + furniture + trunks —

I tem + Give all my house hold + kitchen Furniture To my wife
+ Sons to Peter Aaron H. + Harvey and my daughter Martha W.
McFarlin to be kept together for there mutual benefit so long
as they stay together and at the death of my wife for it to be
equally divided or sold and then divided share + share a Like
among my Sons Peter, Aaron H. + Harvey and my daughter
Martha W. McFarlin to them + their heirs for ever —

I tem and Give all my Stock of every description (not all Ready to hand)
to my wife + Peter + Aaron + Harvey and all the farming utensils

unto my wife + Sons Peter Aaron H and Harvey and my Daughter
Martha W. McFarlin to be kept together for their mutual bene-
fite so long as they stay together and at the death of my
wife for them to be Equally divided (or sold) and then divid-
ed share + share a Like among my Sons Peter Aaron H
and Harvey and my Daughter Martha W. McFarlin to them
+ their heirs for ever

I Item unto my Son Aaron H. McFarlin a negro Girl called
Kate on condition he pay unto my Son James McFarlin
in six months after my Deceased the Sum of three hundred
Twenty five dollars

I Item and Give unto my Son James McFarlin the further
Sum of four hundred dollars to be paid in Six Months after
my Deceased by my Executor and Executrix which said Sum
of Four hundred dollars + the three hundred + Twenty five Doll-
ars to be paid from my Son Aaron H. McFarlin is to be
in full of his share or right or claim he may be entitled
to of my Estate.

I Item and direct my Executor to purchase a negro boy or
Lad between the age of fifteen + Twenty Years to be Given un-
to my Son William McFarlin which said negro shall be
in full of all right or claim he may have to my Estate

I Item and direct my Executor to purchase a negro Girl or
wench between fifteen + Twenty Years of age to be Given un-
to Aaron Turk which negro is in full of all rights or claims
he may have on my Estate in right of his wife Lucy
Turk

I Item and direct my Executor ^{+ Executrix} to pay unto Edward Oxford
the Sum of twenty five Dollars which is in full of all claims
or right he may have by Law from his wife Nancy Ox-
ford to any part of my Estate

I Item and Direct my Executor + Executrix to pay unto my Son
Daniel McFarlin the Sum of Twenty five dollars which is in
full of all claims or right he may have by Law (as my Son)
to any part of my Estate and further I appoint my Loving
Wife as my Executor + my Son Aaron H. McFarlin as my Exe-
cutor to carry my said Will into full Effect - I in witness

whereof I have set my hand and seal this the Twenty Eight
day of February in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and sixteen + American Independence
