 sary. I do give and bequeath unto my beloved
 Wife Mary all and singular my lands & negroes
 and horse & all the rest of my property that I
 possess, her lifetime to dispose of as she thinks
 proper and after her death one half of all the
 property before mentioned go to for all to Robert
 Parting my beloved son being my daughter
 Mrs. Gibbons her husband as Witness my
 hand & Seal this day & date first Written.
 March 5th 1806.
