I do give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary all and Singular my lands & negroes and horses & all the rest of my property that I possess, her lifetime to dispose of as she thinks proper and after her death one half of all the property before mentioned to go to her Will to Robert Parting my beloved son living & giving my daughters Elizabeth Genders my hand as witness my friends & Seal this day & date first written.
