

Copy of the last Will + Testament of Richard Fryer Deed.

In the name of God Amen

Whereas I Richard Fryer of the State of South Carolina and
district of Spartanburgh being in a very low state of health but
sound and disposing mind & memory and calling to mind the
mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for man
to die do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament
in manner and form following that is to say

Principally and first of all I give and recommend my soul
into the hand of Almighty God who gave it and my body I
recommend to the Earth to be decently interred at the discretion of
my Executors and as touching my worldly estate which it
pleased God to bless me with I desire that all my just
debts and funeral charges may be paid

First I give to my son Jonathan Fryer one Negro boy Lure
and one Horse mane Star and one feather bed and furniture

2nd I give to my Daughter Nelly one Negro girl named
Mariah and one colt and one feather bed and furniture

3rd I give to my Daughter Mary one Negro girl named
Meredith and one colt and one feather bed and furniture

4th I give to my Daughter Fanny one Negro boy named
Sam and the black mare and one feather bed and fur-
niture.

5th I give to my son David one Negro boy named Daniel
and the colt that the black mare is in foal with and
one feather bed and furniture

6th After paying out the above legacies and my just debts
I give to my beloved wife Rachel the balance of said Es-
tate real and personal the same property to be hers her life
time or widowhood and after death or marriage I desire
that the whole of my bank be equally divided between my
sons Jonathan & David that is according to quantity and qual-
ity. Then I desire my Executors to sell the balance of my
estate at twelve months credit and after collecting the
money I desire that it be equally divided amongst all
my children that is to say my first wife children and
last wife children. I do hereby ordain and constitute my
beloved wife Rachel and my son Jonathan my Executrix
of this my last Will and Testament. In
witness whereof I set my hand and seal this third day of
January in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred

Benjamin Ledbetter's Will

In the name of God Amen.

I Benjamin Ledbetter being in my proper mind and mem-
ory calling into mind the Mortality of my body and know-
ing that it is appointed for all men to die do make and or-
dain this my last Will and testament first I give and bequeath
unto my daughter Martha one bed and furniture.

Second I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah one
bed and furniture.

Third I give and bequeath unto my son William one
Horse bridle and saddle when my Executors see proper
for him to receive said horse.

Fourth I leave a negro man Harry to be left with my Ex-
ecutor for the education of my children to be disposed of as
they see proper till they come to the age of twenty one and
then which ever of my said children will give the most
for said Negroe Harry is to have him.

Fifth I leave Rebekah and her child Albert and lot and
Middy to be disposed of by the Executors as they see proper
at public or private sale and also my tract of land to be
sold in the same way by said Executors, and all my
Stock of Horses and cattle and Hogs and house hold and
kitchen furniture and plantation tools to be sold at pub-
lic auction and to be equally divided betwixt my daughter
Martha and Sarah and my son John after all charges
and expenses paid I do hereby appoint and Ordain
