Richard Harris's Will

Georgia } Be it known that I Richard Harris of
Jones County } the County and State aforesaid being in a sound
State of Mind and Body but knowing that it is appointed for
all men once to die do make the following disposition of my
property as my last will and testament. Viz - 1st I leave unto
my beloved wife Martha M. Harris the house and square of
land on which I now live together with twenty acres adjoin-
ing Bullard to have and to use during her widowhood only
and it is further my will that she have an equal share
with my children of all my other property according to law
the negroes which were willed to me by Edwin Harris excep-
ted - 2nd I give and bequeath to my five children Nathan
Harris, Nancy Harris, Edwin Noble Harris, Frances Decatur
Harris and Elizabeth Turner Harris, the negroes that were
willed to me by Edwin Harris together with their increase
to be equally divided among them and I further give and
bequeath to my five children aforesaid and their heirs for-
ever all my other property both real and personal to be equal-
ly divided amongst them. It is further my will that my
two negro men Rodrick and Jerry be sold by my Executors
immediately after my death and the proceeds of the sale at
that time be divided equally among my five children
and I further certify that this is my will and desire that so

soon as my five children aforesaid successively arrive at law-
ful age or marry they severally receive their portions
according to the above disposition. 3rd I do further will and
desire that the property lent as above to my wife during her
widowhood be divided at her death or when she marries
equally among my five children aforesaid — 4th I do hereby ap-
point my truly friends Thomas Blount, Dr Thomas Hamilton
and John W. Gordon Executors of this my last will and testa-
ment In testimony whereof, I hereunto set my hand and affix
my seal the Eighth day of September 1827.

dear wife Charlotte Harrison ~~and~~ during her natural life or wid-
owhood for the purpose of supporting her and the small children
and for the purpose of giving the children such an Education as
she may think proper, and further to be disposed of in the fol-
lowing manner Viz: to be given to my sons William Robert
Wheary & Freley Joseph R and Larena D Harrison, as they be-
come of the age of twenty one, or married off to each one good
feather bed and furniture and one Cow and calf, also to my daugh-
ter Mary one good feather bed and one Cow and calf.
2nd At the death of my wife Charlotte I wish to be given to my
daughter Mary one negro girl by the name of Betty and in the
