In the name of God Amen. I Robert Jordan of South Carolina Sumter district planter being weak of body but of a sound mind and memory and calling to mind the mortality of the body - and knowing it is ordained for all men once to die do nominate and constitute this my last will and testament (viz) First I give my soul unto God that gave it and my body to be buried at the discretion of my executors here after mentioned and as touching my worldly property that it hath pleased God to bless me with, I give and dispose of in the following manner and from hence after men times first it is I lend to my daughter Mary, one negro girl named Leah and five head of cattle one mare and one feather bed and furniture and the increase during her life time and if she die without a lawful issue the property to return to the nearest heir in the family. In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1827.

is my will that she shall have no more of my property for  
she has received her part all ready from my estate, I lend to  
my daughter Ann one feather bed and furniture during her  
lifetime and if she dies without a lawfull issue the property to re-  
turn to the nearest heir in the family, I lend to my daughter  
Rebecca one negro woman named Jane and during her  
lifetime and if she dies without a lawfull issue the property  
to return to the nearest heir in the family, I lend to my son  
John one negro boy named Jacob and one feather bed and  
furniture during his lifetime and if he dies without a lawfull  
begotten heir the property to return to the nearest heir in the  
family, I lend to my daughter Jane one negro girl named  
Pinah and her increase during her lifetime, I lend to my  
daughter Sarah one negro woman named Bess and one  
negro boy named Simon during her lifetime, and one box  
fat and if she dies without a lawfull issue the property to  
return to the nearest heir in the family, I lend to my son  
James one negro boy named Prince one feather bed and fur-  
niture during his lifetime and if he dies without a lawfull be-  
gotten heir the property to return to the nearest heir in the  
family, I lend to my daughter Martha one negro boy named  
Peter during her lifetime and if she dies without a lawfull  
issue - the property to return to the nearest heir in the fam-  
ily, I lend to my son George one negro boy named  
Stephens and one feather bed and furniture and one desk  
and box during his lifetime and if he dies without a lawfull  
begotten heir the property to return to the nearest heir in  
the family, it is my will that the rest of my property - my  
cattle hogs & sheep tank house furniture and kitchen fur-
