discretion of my Executors 2 Secondly I bequeath to my
well beloved wife Joanna Barron the Square or lot of
Land number six in the tenth district of Jones County toget-
her with the house thereon and all the household furniture to
be disposed of as she may think proper together with thirteen
Negroes (viz) Phebe Grace Burch Luman Jincy Agg Mary
Lue Limer Eliza Sampson Jacob Charity and one gig and
harness

3 Thirdly I will and bequeath to my daughter Sarah four
Negroes (viz) Mariah Pae Rose and James

4 fourthly I will and bequeath to my son James Barron six
hundred & fifty dollars all ready Received.

5 fifthly I will and bequeath to my son Waley Barron one
Negro Man named Tom & one hundred dollars in money
all Ready received

6 Sixtly I will and bequeath to my Son William Barron one negro man named Lame all ready releved.

7 Seventhly I will and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Barron one negro man named Prince one Negro Woman Charlotte and Clary Mally & Lize.

8 Eightly I will and bequeath to my daughter Rebekah Barron now the wife of James Lockett the following property to wit all my Turner Creezy Jerry as his full proportionable part of the estate of the said Samuel Barron

9 Ninthly I will and bequeath all the Balance of my property to my sons viz Benjamin Jonathan Wallis Thomas Rivers Arenton Barron to be divided Equally between their five children.

I now appoint James Billinglea and Adam Carson my Executor to this my last will & testament in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this tenth day of July one thousand eight hundred and twenty three Signed sealed and delivered.
