Georgia I, William Davidson of the County and State of Jones County, aforesaid being in perfect health and sound mind and disposing memory, but calling to mind the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death do hereby make publish and declare this my last will and testament to wit I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Nancy in case I should survive her all that lot or tract of land whereon I now reside to have and to hold ^{the} said tract of land for and during the term of her widowhood; and at her death or marriage my will and desire is that the said tract of land shall be sold to the best advantage and the money arising therefrom to be equally divided share and share alike between my six sons Richard Davidson John Davidson William Davidson Talbot Davidson Green Davidson and James Davidson.

I also give and bequeath to my beloved wife Nancy all my personal property estate such as horses cattle hogs &c all my household furniture of what kind or description soever and every other article of property of which I may be possessed to have and to hold I enjoy for and during the term of her widowhood; and at her death or marriage I give and bequeath to my daughter Nancy Davidson all my said personal estate such as horses cattle hogs &c and in case of the death of my daughter Nancy before marriage my will and desire is that all my personal estate shall be equally divided share and share alike between my said sons.

In the name of God Amen I Joshua Harris Sen. of the
State of Georgia and County of Jones being in good health
and of a sound mind & memory do constitute and or-
dain this my last will & testament first recommend-
ing my soul to god that gave it and my body to the dust
from whence it came and as to my worldly goods
I dispose of as follows. I item the 1st I give to my son
Joshua Harris one negro woman and increase named
Lucy one negro man named Abraham one boy by the
name of David one boy the name of Peter one by the
name of Sam and the land whereon I now live it con-
taining Eighty Seven and one half acres of land be the
same more or less it joining Rose & others & a part
of a fraction on the Ockmulgee River and all the Stock
of Every kind Household & Kitchen furniture but if the said
Joshua Harris Junr. should die without issue then
the above estate to be equally divided between James
Harris Children & Sally Harris Children I item 2 & I give
my daughter Nancy Green Child a negro woman
