In the name of God. Amen, I William A. Allen of the
County of Jones & State of Georgia being very sick & weak
in Body, but of perfect mind & memory thanks be
given to God, and as touching such worldly estate
wherein it hath pleased God to bless me in this
life with, I give demise & dispose of the same in the
following manner & form. First, It is my Will &
desire that all my personal property together with
my land shall be sold at publick Sale giving twenty
months credit taking bonds bearing interest from
the date (except such property as I give grants for the
support of the family) and after these bonds are col-
lected together with the accounts which are due
me at this I wish the money laid out to the
best advantage in likely young increasing Negroes,
which negroes will then be at the disposal, or
management of my Executors for the use of my
family. It is also my Will & desire that my son James

shall be bound at the age of Seventeen untill he is twenty one to some steady who will learn him a trade which he likes. It is my Will that my Executors shall purchase some convenient lot with a house on it for the use of my Wife Polly Allen. It is also my Will that Mrs. Sabthal Gordys Children inherit the property which she has of mine in her possession. It is also my will and desire that after my son James becomes of age that all my property shall be equally divided between my Wife + Children. I do constitute + Ordain John + Harrie Allen my Executors. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand + Seal ^{this} twenty seventh day of Nov^r in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred + thirteen.
