Item, I Will that my executors dispose of my joiners tools, as much of the farming tools as can be conveniently spared from the use of the farm, as much cotton + as much wheat, as circumstances will admit of in their judgments from the necessary support of the family, and that they dispose of the above articles in the manner they can, or their judgment will admit, and apply the money arising therefrom to the payment of my debts. And last of all I constitute + appoint my dearly beloved wife Nancy Stone, my very good friends, Francis Coleman + Mansell Tomack to be my executors to this my last Will + Testament, hereby revoking and disannulling all former Wills + testaments made or obtained by me at any time heretofore, declaring to be and no other my last Will + Testament and I invite my very good friends, David White, + John Clegg to sign their names
